# **Child Safety Requirements**

Children can strangle if child safety devices are not installed and correctly adjusted. Please read the instructions carefully and install correctly. Always use child safety devices to keep cords or chains out of reach of children.

# Installation

### Chain and cord loop tensioners and retainers

These devices must be securely fixed at the maximum distance possible from the control such that the cord or chain loop will not become slack and should be at least 1.5 m from the floor.

### **Cleats**

Cleat must be securely fixed at least 1.5m from the floor. A second cleat must be installed above the first if it is not possible to store all the cord on one cleat when the blind is fully raised.

### Instructions and labels

Product must identify manufacturer name or trademark (this can be internal to the blind). All warning labels must be left on the product for the end user. Product instructions must be left with the customer (and end user in the case of OEM).

## **Breakaway devices**

In the event these are actuated do not operate the blind without first reconnecting.

- Pull cords breakaway connector.
- Roman blind click ring / connector.
- Chain loop break open connector.




# **Attention:**




# A Cord tidy will be supplied and must be fitted with all cord or chain loop operated blinds.


The cord tidy is a two piece device and will arrive with a disposable red tab fitted to it.




1. Remove the disposable red tab by disengaging it from the cord and then pull out the disposable red tab.



- 2. Position the cord tidy to the wall at the furthest distance below the roller tube adding appropriate tension to the cord and mark its location.
- 3. Split the cord tidy and mark the remaining offset hole position before drilling both location holes. Screw into the offset hole to fix the piece of cord tidy to the wall.



4. Re-assemble the cord tidy with the cord and fix it in previously marked position with a screw through the centre hole.



5. Push fit a cover cap over the screw hole opening.




### Please note:


- If the blind drop is less than 2.5m cord length must be 1m or less.
- If blind drop is greater than 2.5m cord length must be drop of blind less 1.5m.

## A Cord tidy will be supplied and must be fitted with all cord or chain loop operated blinds.


The cord tidy is a two piece device and will arrive with a disposable cord tie fitted to it.




1. Remove the cord tie




2. Position the cord tidy to the wall at the furthest distance below the roller tube adding appropriate tension to the cord and mark the position of both holes.




3. Using a pilot drill, drill both location holes



4. Fit srews through both holes making sure the cord is retained.



5. Securely push the rubber cover into the cord tidy.



### Please note:

- 6. If the blind drop is less than 2.5m cord length must be 1m or less.
- 7. If blind drop is greater than 2.5m cord length must be drop of blind less 1.5m.
















### To raise blind


- 1. Pull acorn down and towards the centre of the blind.
- 2. Move acorn back to edge of blind under button hole
- 3. Release cord slowly

### To Lower blind


- 1. Pull acorn down and towards the centre of the blind.
- 2. Release cord slowly
- 3. Allow the weight of the blind to lower the blind


### Blinds with 3 - 4 lift cords





# Blinds with 2 lift cords




Blinds with 3 - 4 lift cords
